Who is SmartStart Early Learning?

SmartStart is a *successful national network* of NGOs and partners that is realising quality, affordable early learning for all children aged three to five. We are achieving this by *scaling a network of and building a platform for providers, achieving specific ecosystem transformations with governments and partners, and promoting <i>early learning as a priority societal cause*.

Purpose

The Senior Development Head will enable SmartStart's scale trajectory by leading the network's strategic fundraising for increasingly large unrestricted funding from an appropriate mix of sources, including cultivating and stewarding principled relationships with funders and leading development-related communications.

The successful individual will be a **curious**, creative, driven fundraising professional with extensive experience **catalysing funders to action for a societal cause**.

Key Responsibilities

- Lead fundraising of R350m *unrestricted* for financial year 2025-26 and significantly more for each year after with an appropriate, evolving mix of funding types and sources
- Drive **significant increase in state funding** across sources for (SmartStart) practitioners-and-programmes as well as the SmartStart platform
- Guide, develop, pursue and refine **development strategy** that secures the funds SmartStart needs now and builds the relationships and reputation to succeed into the future
 - o Identify and pursue appropriate funders new to SmartStart
- **Develop and steward principled partnerships and relationships** with (potential) investors and/or other funders, donors, sponsors, and supporters internationally (incl. in South Africa)
- Lead and manage development communications by representing and narrating SmartStart with relevant audiences and constituencies, incl. producing & disseminating content for different development audiences in collaboration with relevant colleagues
- Manage the development life-cycle incl. generating leads; making contacts; developing proposals and/or pitching; building relationships; and reporting

Qualifications and Experience

- Master's degree (or equivalent) in a related discipline
- At least 8 years' relevant & diverse experience in complex organisational-systemic contexts, ideally incl. early childhood development, education, or public health
- Min. 4 years in senior role(s) successfully leading functions and managing teams
- Advantageous: fluency in one or more African languages
